5. Annual report of the Chairman

***Report given relating to a busy year for the Council, highlighting the Save Greasley campaign, VE Day and upcoming events. Thanked all staff and Councillors for their assistance throughout the year, especially the residents who have overwhelmingly supported the Parish Council this year.

6. Matters raised by members of the public

Resident raised concerns regarding the proposed garage on Nottingham Road which is scheduled for 11th June planning committee.

Resident asked if a member of Greasley Parish Council would be willing to speak at the Planning Committee on behalf of the residents.

A planning officer has attended site and the conversation was overheard by residents. The comments made by the applicant during the conversation are disputed by the residents.

Responses have been received to emails but these have not answered the questions raised by residents.

A discussion was held regarding the intricacies of the application and how the Parish Council can support the residents.



In conclusion, residents want the applicant to adhere to the permitted scheme and drawing initially approved by the Borough Council, with no variations. Clerk is to check the Councillors schedules and see if any cllrs are available to attend the planning committee meeting. A response is set to be submitted to BBC from the Parish Council.

Councillors highlighted that all the Parish can do is support the residents and comment, but the decision ultimately lies with Broxtowe Borough Council's planning committee.

Councillor Williamson highlighted that she is a substitute on the planning committee and therefore wishes to remain un-determined on the application until it is debated at committee.

Resident highlighted the lack of signage on the end of Charlesworth Ave and it is an accident waiting to happen on a bend near the mini-island.

Residents also raised that 30mph signage is not suitable around the bend near Watnall Farm Shop. Speed cameras would also be welcomed on this stretch of road. The new development at Hucknall is also causing an increase in traffic. Clerk to raise the issues with County Highways.

Councillors discussed the prior actions taken by past councillors and officers so Highways are aware of the problems but no solution has yet been forthcoming from NCC.

Councillors advised that the Council can organise speedwatch with the police but need volunteer support if they can gather volunteers.
