You may have seen that Juliet Campbell has announced in her latest newsletter that £60,000 has been awarded to deal with flooding in 'Eastwood' by which she means the Coach Drive area. I spoke to her on Thursday about this and explained to her about the proposed water control valve at Moorgreen Reservoir and how by controlling the water level in the reservoir it could act as a giant flood alleviation pond to greatly reduce the likelihood of future flooding not just of the Coach Drive area but also benefit communities downstream at Langley Mill, Ilkeston and Stapleford which were also badly affected by storm Babet. She seemed genuinely interested in using the money for that but I have since found out that the money has already been allocated to the County Council for the cost of the flood modelling study of the Coach Drive/Moorgreen Reservoir catchment area that has recently been done. So it appears that it is not 'new funding' that can be used to reduce the risk to residents.
